WHAT IS A R.I.S.O.?

R.I.S.O. is an acronym that stands for "Registered Independent Student Organization"

WHO NEEDS AN APPLICATION?

New and Returning R.I.S.O.'s will need to complete an application if there have been any changes to your officers or advisor.

HOW DO I START A R.I.S.O.?

The first step is getting an application.

Applications are available during the current school semester.

IF YOU ARE RENEWING YOUR APPLICATION?

If you are renewing, an email with the

subject line: "Renewing"

in the email message: { Club name; no changes }

EXAMPLE: LIFE Club; no change

WHERE DO I GET AN APPLICATION?

R.I.S.O. applications are available two ways:

1) Stop by the Student Life and Development Office and pick up an Application.

(Application can be typed or written)

2) Visit our Student Life and Development website online

and download our form fillable digital application from our website.

WHERE DO I TURN IN THE APPLICATION?

The completed application can be submitted to the Student Life and Development office in Building 2, Room 113, or it can be electronically submitted to hccsld@hawaii.edu

HOW DO I FILL OUT AN APPLICATION?

To start/continue a R.I.S.O you need the following:

- 1. At least 5 student members
- 2. A faculty or staff advisor
- 3. A club constitution, http://tinyurl.com/RISO-Constitution
- 4. A sample of the constitution is located on our website

If you're a continuing R.I.S.O you will also need the following:

- 1. Meeting minutes confirming election of your officers
- 2. The most current, updated copy of you constitution
- 3. A current roster of your members (Member Roster)

Format the Subject Line of your email to say: Purchase Worksheet, (RISO name), (Event Name) Sample: Purchase Worksheet, Gamer Club Pokémon Tournament.

RISO inquiries are only handled on Tuesdays. It is best to submit by 2:30 PM on these days for the quickest processing

Who: RISO Groups who request funding from any CSO. Requests are accepted only for events open to all HonCC Students, Faculty, and Staff.

Attendees: Minimum 1 Officer, 1 Advisor attends meetings from each RISO Group. Only those who attend will be able to submit paperwork for the organization. We recommended other officers attend so they understand as well
